Subject: FRANCE - AERODROME OPERATING MINIMA

ADOPTION OF EU-OPS AS STATE MINIMA IN FRANCE

With AIP AIRAC Supplement France 031/2011, Eff 30 June 2011, the French Authorities have published State Aerodrome Operating Minima based on EU-OPS Appendix 1 (New) to OPS 1.430, for the majority of the French airports. Please refer to ATC pages France dated 17-Jun-2011 for further details. Jeppesen is in the process of applying these minima to the France charts.

Converted charts can be identified with the **Standard** label on the minimums box:

As an interim solution, 10-9S pages will be provided to all customers for those airports where the new "Standard" minimums are not yet incorporated into the charts.

These 10-9S pages contain State Minimum values which are applicable to all operators.

On the 24th June, a list of airports will be provided on Jeppesen.com, informing you of which charts have not yet been converted to EU-OPS and for which a 10-9S must be used for applying the new minima. This list will be updated on a weekly basis, until all locations have been converted.
