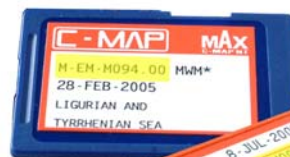
This Alert is related to MAX cartridge and MAXonPC CD chart products. It is NOT related to C-Map NT or NT+ products.

To find the code of your cartridge look at the label on the front face of the cartridge - see yellow highlighted area in picture.

If you are using MAXonPC charts on CD-Rom run the Selector program and go to the Shopping Cart page to see if you have purchased one of the areas listed above.

It has been discovered that the above listed C-MAP Max products do not include Australian HO chart AUS 4620 "Percy Isles to Booby Island inc. Gulf of Papua" which is a small scale 1:1,500,000 chart covering North East Australia – see diagram on next page.

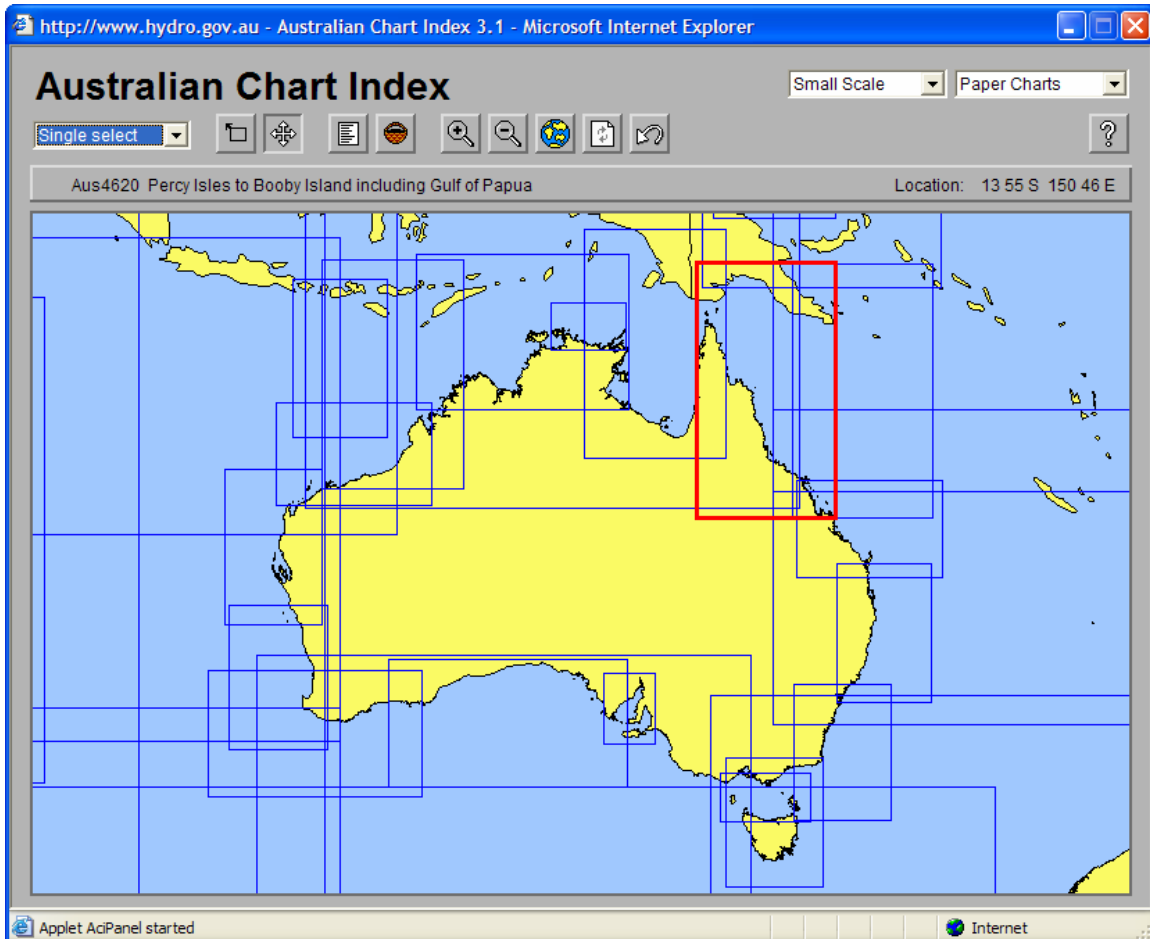
