These General Terms and Conditions of Sale ("General Terms and Conditions of Sale") apply to the Order to which they are attached for the services described therein.

The Fleet Manager and VVOS subscriptions (the "Subscriptions") are annual subscriptions that run for a period of 12 months and include a license to use the applicable software (in accordance with the terms of the then-current applicable software license agreement), and certain related services as identified in the Order. The Fleet Manager subscription is a web-based subscription and the VVOS subscription is provided on a per-vessel basis.

Customer may request Other Services on an ad-hoc basis as identified in the Order, which such services are provided in accordance with Jeppesen's then-current fee schedule and are subject to these General Terms and Conditions of Sale.

#### **1. Validity and Termination**

Upon the end of a Subscription period, customer's Subscription will be automatically renewed for additional periods of 12 months each unless customer gives Jeppesen a notice of termination no less than three (3) months prior to the expiry of the then-current Subscription period. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Subscriptions and Other Services will terminate automatically if customer fails to comply with any term of these General Terms and Conditions of Sale. No refund will be made in the case of termination of a subscription during any Subscription period or termination of Other Services.

#### **3. Price, Invoice and Payment**

3.1. Customer agrees to pay Jeppesen monthly in advance in the stated currency and at the prices set forth in the Order for any Subscription, which prices may be modified by Jeppesen on an annual basis. Customer agrees to pay Jeppesen for Other Services in advance by (i) providing customer's credit card information to Jeppesen or (ii) paying monthly, as applicable. All prices are net of withholding or other similar taxes to which such payments may be subject and are exclusive of value added or similar taxes and shipping and handling charges, if any.

3.2. Invoices and/or renewal notices are payable within 30 days from their date. Customer will be liable for all costs incurred by Jeppesen for collection of any outstanding amounts due, including without limitation attorneys' fees and court costs.

3.3. The acceptance by Jeppesen of late invoice payments will not constitute waiver of default in payment or of any other default. Jeppesen will have the right to set off any

credits, overpayments or other forms of security or deposits against any amounts owing by customer to Jeppesen and to charge interest in the amount of one and one-half percent (1.5%) per month or the maximum amount permitted by law for any invoices in default. Jeppesen further reserves the right in the event of non-payment by customer to terminate customer's Subscription and/or delay delivery of any updated information until such time as payment is received by Jeppesen.

#### **6. Governing Law and Legal Venue**

6.1. These General Terms and Conditions of Sale will be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of New York, U.S.A., without recourse to choice of law statutes or principles that would otherwise result in the application of the law of any other jurisdiction to these General Terms and Conditions of Sale. The United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods will not apply to these General Terms and Conditions of Sale.

6.2. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to these General Terms and Conditions of Sale or breach thereof, will be finally settled under the Rules of Conciliation and Arbitration of the International Chamber of Commerce by one or more arbitrators appointed in accordance with the said Rules. The place of arbitration will be New York, New York U.S.A. The language of arbitration will be English. This arbitration clause will not deprive any of the parties from seeking interim injunctive relief in national courts of competent jurisdiction.
