Departure Procedures invalid for Multiple Airports

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1005, effective 06 May 2010, contains incorrect Departure Procedure information for multiple airports in Bolivia. Bolivia AIP AMDT 23/10 was received after the date specified by ICAO for aeronautical information distribution. As a result, the changes contained therein could not be processed for the 6 May 2010 effective date. The changes included multiple Departures listed below.

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE DEPARTURE PROCEDURES LISTED BELOW IN CYCLE 1005 NAVDATA FOR BOLIVIA:

All Departures from Runway 28 at La Paz, El Alto Intl Airport (SLLP) cross PAZ VOR at or above 13500'

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1006, effective 03 June 2010.
